


































































Osteophytectomy, excision osteoid osteoma, lipoma excision, loose body removal, debridement for synovial osteochondromatosis, assessment pre-osteotomy, debridement for fracture non-union, resection of acetabular labrum, labral repair, debridement for osteoarthritis, synovectomy (rheumatoid, PVNS), psoas tenotomy, ITB release, trochanteric bursectomy, shrinkage ligamentum teres, acetabular recession, excision of impingement lesion (FAI), cyst curettage, assessment of painful resurfacing arthroplasty, excision of osteochondritis dissecans fragment, AVN, excision iliopsoas bursa, debridement for Perthes' disease, foreign body retrieval, removal of bone fragments, debridement of crystalline arthropathy, chondroplasty, release of arthrofibrosis, debridement and drainage for septic arthritis, debridement for chondromalacia, excision of ganglion, excision of haemangioma, evacuation haemarthrosis, chondral repair, excision paralabral cyst, repositioning of acetabular liner...
